

Baptisms (Christenings)

Please do get in touch if you are interested in having your child baptised (Christened). Baptism is the start of a lifetime's journey following Jesus. As baptism is about becoming part of the church family, the first step is to come along to one of our services where we would love to meet you. The all-age services are ideal for this, but you are welcome on any Sunday.

We will then arrange a date for the baptism and meet with you to talk about the service, explain the role of godparents and answer any questions you may have.

Baptisms take place within our 10.45am service, usually on the third Sunday of the month, however, the service is centred around the baptism, making it a special occasion for your family and friends.
