About

The trust was established using money invested from the sale of the Chinnor Old Church of England Primary School. Each year we use the interest from that money to provide a small fund to support children and young people to pursue their education goals.

How can we help?

The charity provides small grants to children and young people under the age of 25 who are resident in the parishes of Chinnor and Sydenham. There is no means testing, and you do not need to be a worshipper at any of the churches in the parish. All are welcome to apply.

These grants are to help in the provision of educational requirements of any kind not normally provided by the local education authority. These typically include:

1. Books, equipment, clothing, tools or instruments to assist you to pursue your education.
2. Equipment to prepare for a profession or trade after completing secondary or tertiary education
3. Additional education courses.

Typical grants range between £50 - £250, although we do consider larger requests.
