25th February: Canon Dr Clare Amos

'The Gospel of Matthew - A mountain-top experience'

Clare's talk offers an introduction to this particular Gospel, drawing in art and music, as well as theological reflection.

Until her retirement Canon Dr Clare Amos was head of the interreligious office at the World Council of Churches, Geneva. She is a biblical scholar and teacher by background and enjoys sharing her enthusiasm for scripture with a wide range of people, both lay and ordained.

4th March: Professor Christopher Hancock.

'By what authority? Identity and conflict within the Church'

Professor Christopher Hancock is the Founding Director at Oxford House Research Ltd. Historically a theologian, who taught at Cambridge University and in the USA, his work has focused in the last twenty years on culture, ethics, and religion in contemporary geopolitics.

11th March: Dr. David Edwin Orton P.H.D L.L.M.

"Interpreting the Bible for the Church",

Dr David Orton is an established translator and editor primarily working in the fields of Biblical studies, theology and religion.

18th March: Revd Dr Helen Williams

'Science and Faith'

Revd Dr Helen has a PhD from Cambridge in Astrophysics, specialising in the study of intergalactic gas clouds. She has previously been a science teacher and is an ordained priest, currently serving as the Team Vicar in the Shaftesbury Benefice.
