- (i) Please provide full legal names
- (ii) If one (or both) of the people intending to get married are divorced there is an extra stage required before the application can be approved. Please contact the Rector to arrange for this to take place. For this you will need to provide details of the previous marriage, a copy of the decree absolute and speak about the current relationship.
- (iii) Banns are normally published over a period of 3 months before the marriage. If you do not know the address at this time please leave blank. However, we will need to know the address before calling banns. If your address will change between calling banns and getting married please contact us as soon as possible so that we can make sure that the necessary legal preliminaries are completed.

ONCE YOU HAVE COMPLETED THIS FORM

1. We will check the date, time and church and confirm that they are available. We will then write to confirm these details. **Please note that until you have received this confirmation there is no firm booking** – some of our churches are busy and used for a wide range of services and events. If we cannot meet your requested date, time or church we will do our best to find a convenient alternative.
2. You will meet with the Minister taking your wedding to plan the service, get to know one another better and during wedding preparation the Minister will help you explore what marriage means to you.
3. Normally 'banns' will be called on three Sundays over three month before you get married. You are encouraged to join us on these occasions if possible, when we will pray for you and the other couples preparing to get married. If you live outside the Benefice of Mid Marsh, banns will also need calling in the parish(es) in which you live, this is your responsibility to arrange.
4. We will arrange a suitable time for the wedding rehearsal – wherever possible this will take place on the afternoon or evening before the wedding.
