Confirmation Preparation 2026

Confirmation preparation for 2026 will be done in the Deanery (Rev'd Kathryn will be involved). Confirmation courses are a wonderful opportunity to explore Christian faith over ten weekly sessions, together with others.

The course may be in preparation for your Confirmation, or, the course may be a refresher about the Christian Faith for you or. A Confirmation Service is a service where the promises made at your baptism are now affirmed by you as an adult and you receive the laying on of hands and anointing with oil by a bishop confirming you in the Christian faith. (If you have not been baptised, this may happen during the confirmation service at in your parish before the Confirmation Service.)

The course will ten one hour sessions from 7-8pm. The venue will be at Church House next to All Saints Church in Evesham.

Bishop Hugh arrives in the Diocese

On 17 January, we officially welcomed Hugh Nelson as the next Bishop of Worcester. As he joins us, he will be spending time getting to know Worcestershire and Dudley and its people as well as finding out more about what's happening in our churches.

Bishop Hugh said:

"Our diocesan vision is to be Kingdom People, who are part of a network of flourishing churches of all kinds, sizes and styles, with a particular focus on children, young people and their families. To be Kingdom People is to look for the signs of God at work in the world around us, to be of service to our communities – especially those most in need - and to constantly point people towards the goodness and love of Jesus. What a great vision that is!"

"I am so looking forward to getting out and about, visiting churches, schools and communities and meeting God's Kingdom People in every part of the Diocese."

As Hugh arrives, a programme is being planned for him to visit as much of the Diocese as possible, meeting clergy and lay leaders as well as congregation members. He will be looking particularly for places where he can hear from children and young people through schools, youth groups and

other church-run activities. "Jesus told us that the Kingdom is like a community with a child at the centre, so I want to find out what children and young people think of God and what they'd like from church, regardless of whether they currently attend, or even consider themselves Christians."

Alongside being Bishop of Worcester, Hugh will continue to be Bishop to the Armed Forces. His youngest daughter is in the final year of her A-levels, so in the first few months, he will be travelling back to Truro for a couple of days each week until his wife Lizzie and daughter can join him in Worcester after the exams are over.

Hugh continued: "It is an exciting time to be joining the Diocese of Worcester. God is doing something in our culture at the moment, and there is a new openness to faith. I already know that there are so many people dedicated to serving their community faithfully within and beyond our church buildings. I am looking forward to working, praying, serving and worshipping with you, so that together we can become, even more fully, God's Kingdom People across Worcestershire and Dudley."

The Lenten Season as Housekeeping

We are fast approaching Lent, a season of spiritual, relational, material housekeeping.

In our spiritual lives we make time for reflection and prayer. We read works which will challenge us – Lent books are recommended each year. We make time to meditate on the Bible and Christian life in a Lent Course. We try to do some of these things together with others to enjoy the wisdom and stories of others with whom we are related by faith. Keep an eye out for our Lent Groups 2026 exploring prayer.

One aspect of Lenten Housekeeping which we do not speak much is almsgiving: Giving money away. This is one of five pillars of the Islamic faith, but not so explicitly of the Christian faith. Generous giving is taken for granted in Judeo-Christian understanding, but because we are uncomfortable talking about giving money, we do not do it. Some choose as a Lenten discipline to give away money and testify to both the terror and joy of giving away sums which challenged their budget.

What we do with our wealth is often a sign of where our hearts are at in relation to God. Jesus reminded us of this. It may be something for you to consider this Lent?

I was reminded that 23 February marks Funeral Planning Awareness Week. An important aspect of housekeeping too. Thinking about our funerals and what we want to happen to our wealth and

possessions when we die may be a difficult but important aspect of Lenten Housekeeping. Many charities, including the church, benefit from money left to them.

What will you be laying down and taking up this Lent?






