

Leconfield Interfaith Group Meeting 9.2.26

Nine of us met together this time. At our last few meetings we have had a guest to share their faith journey with us. This time we had decided to take time to reflect on our experience and to think about how we want to move forward. After some silence, we started to explore our collective interfaith journey so far.



Over the last year or so we have been able to explore a variety of faith traditions with the help of our guests. These have included - Greek Orthodox, Jewish, Muslim and Buddhist, as well as our own Anglican and Quaker roots. And it was good to hear recently about the development of interfaith dialogue within East Yorkshire and Hull through the work of HERI - Hull and East Riding interfaith. We are not alone in our concerns to maintain a dialogue across the boundaries of faith and belief.

We realised that the field of our enquiry is truly vast. There are just so many strands of faith - within each of the Abrahamic traditions, Christian, Jewish and Muslim, for instance, and beyond.

As we come together for our meetings to share our own perspectives we find we are developing a deep sense of fellowship and trust. Hearing about and understanding our differences, we realise that there is so much more that unites us.


