Sunday 12th April, final date for applications to join the **Electoral Roll**. The revised roll (names only) will be displayed from Sunday 19th.

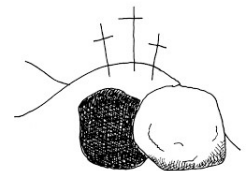
