THE DIAMOND CENTRE FOR DISABLED RIDERS, Woodmansterne Road, Carshalton provides therapeutic riding activities and carriage driving for children and adults with disabilities. Unique facilities benefit disabled children and adults by having regular contact with horses, either through riding or driving. Around 350 Riders per week attend, all with a disability - ages range from 3 to 75+ years old and each week riders and drivers enjoy half an hour or so when with the assistance of the instructors and helpers - who are mainly volunteers - they can enjoy the experience which helps improve their capabilities, and takes them out of their restricted daily lives - and puts smiles on their faces. For many of them it is one of only few sports they can participate in and experience some form of independence and sense of achievement.
