MEMORIAL PLAQUES

Following several enquiries, the District Church Council (DCC) has agreed to dedicate a bench on the main path to the Church for the installation of Memorial plaques. There will be one bench with numerous plaques on it.

Anyone wishing to have a plaque on this bench must adhere to the following procedure:

1. Contact the DCC secretary Judy Hinksman on 01562 851602 who will supply you with the brass plaque. The cost of the plaque is £10 and should be paid for in CASH on collection. Judy will advise you of the appropriate wording to be placed on the plaque.
2. The plaque should be engraved by a professional engraver with your wording (no photographs). We can recommend 'Severn Valley Locks', who are located opposite Kidderminster Train Station. Please note that no photographs are permitted.
3. The completed plaque should be returned to the DCC secretary for approval and we will fix the plaque on the bench for you.
4. The DCC reserves the right to reject inappropriate wording and engraving and remove any plaques put there without following the correct procedure.
5. Once sited the plaque becomes the property of the Church.
