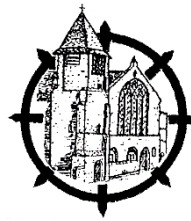

NOTES ON THE READINGS

The First Reading

The Holy Spirit is given, and the mission of the Church begins.

The Responsorial Psalm

The Psalmist asks God to send his spirit to renew creation.

The Second Reading

Saint Paul explains that there is only one Holy Spirit. No matter what gifts we have, we all belong to the same body.

The Gospel

In the Gospel we hear the first greeting of Jesus to his disciples after the resurrection. He gives them the promised Holy Spirit.
