

9.00 am Holy Communion BCP (1662)

CUSTOMARY

8.30 am open up school yard

8.35 am power on to PA and ensure PA is on.

Table/Altar: assume the celebrant will be facing East.

Silver safe: St Wilfrid's paten and chalice
Ciborium

Vicar's chest: charge chalice
1 x host on paten
10x hosts in Ciborium

Nave Altar/High Altar (face) East.

- Remove corporal from burse and unfold
- Chalice charged with wine towards the close end of corporal at 6 o'clock
- Purificator on top.
- Place patten with priest's host on top
- Place Pall on top
- Cover with veil
- Place the ciborium from immediately behind the veiled paten and chalice at
- Place the burse about 45 degrees facing inwards at 2.00 o'clock as you face East
- Book stand with folder at 10 o'clock as you face East

Credence table

- Water (from the plastic bottle as its out of sight, so its fine)
- Lavabo
- Purificator

8.45 am Ring the Angelus. (3x3 + 9)

Open the doors

8.50 am light candles

8.55 am Ring the Angelus

After the service

The priest will have removed all the objects from the altar/table and placed them on the credence.

Make sure the vessels have been sanitised. If different patens and chalices are to be used at 10.00 replace the St Wilfrid's set in the silver safe.

Any hosts left over from the 9.00 am can be decanted into the little ciborium in the aumbry.
