**This morning's hymns are...**

**212 Holy, Holy, Holy**

Bishop of Calcutta Reginald Heber, whose family lived at Hodnet Hall in Shropshire, wrote this hymn for Trinity Sunday.

**333 May the grace of Christ our Saviour**

John Newton's hymn reflects the Trinitarian blessing of 2 Corinthians 13 read today. Newton was a sailor and slave trader who converted to Christianity and became a pastor. His hymn expresses joy, communion and spiritual blessings that surpass earthly experiences, highlighting the grace, love and fellowship of our Triune God.

**514 Thou whose almighty word**

This is a hymn that praises God for his light, both physical and spiritual. It was written by John Marriott and refers to the creation story in Genesis and then asks us to take his light into the dark places of His world.

**522 God be the glory**

This is one of 8,000 hymns attributed to Frances Alstyne, nee Crosby, a relative of Bing. Despite being blind from childhood she became an inspiration to human rights activists.

## 2 Corinthians 13 11-end

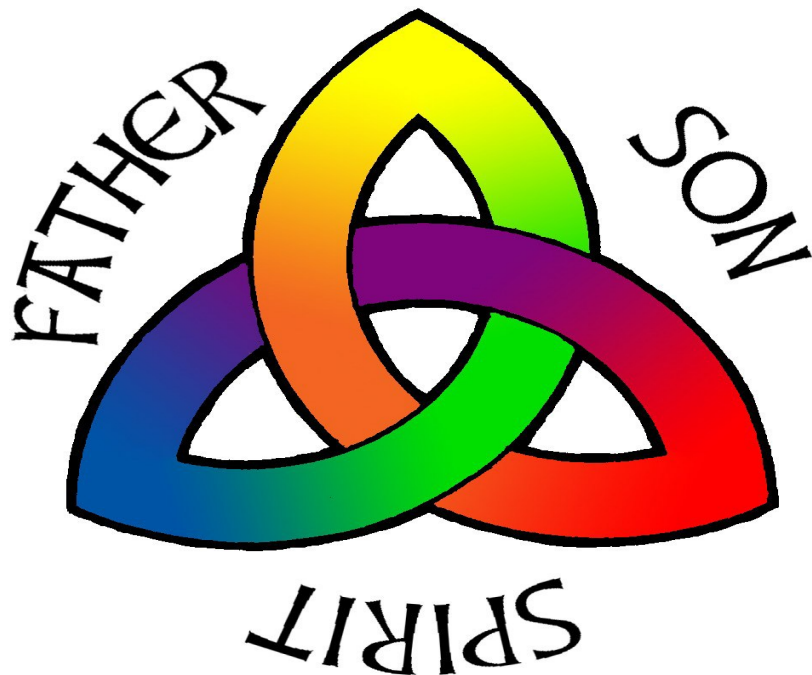
Finally, brothers and sisters, farewell. Put things in order, listen to my appeal, agree with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you.
