## CUSTOMARY for 10.00 Parish Eucharist

09.45

- Crucifer to Ring the Angelus
- Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon Prepare the Credence Table (Chapel of the Resurrection)
  - \*Sacred Vessels on Corporal
  - \*Chalice (s) (charged)
  - \*Paten with Priest's Host
  - \*Cover with Pall, Burse (containing 2<sup>nd</sup> Corporal) and Veil
  - \*Wafer Box with 20 wafers
  - \*Cruet
  - \*Lavabo bowl
  - \*4 Purificators (Priest's chalice, 2 communicants' chalices + lavabo)
  - \*Ciborium with 45 hosts to Wardens' Stall
  - \*Flagon (charged) to Wardens' Stall
  - \*Light the candles (+ Paschal Candle in season)

- Crucifer to Ring the Angelus
- Crucifer, torch bearers and choir to assemble in Narthex
- Introit organ music

10.00

- Bell
- Introit Hymn  
Procession  
(Move off in 2<sup>nd</sup> Verse)

**X**  
**Choir**  
**Torch 1 Torch 2**  
**Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon**  
**Celebrant**

**Station on altar platform**  
**Crucifer to Rood**  
**Torch 1 to N**  
**Torch 2 to S**  
**Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon to centre**  
**Celebrant to Centre behind**  
Bow with crucifer

Crucifer to N stall  
Gospel book S side altar  
Gospel Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon to S Stall  
Celebrant to Throne  
Torch to seats on N side.  
Welcome and Penitential Rite, Gloria (in season) and Collect  
All sit with the Celebrant.

**Gospel Procession (with or without Gradual Hymn or Psalm)**

- Crucifer to foot of nave altar platform facing East  
Torch bearers to stands facing East  
Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon to S altar facing East  
Celebrant to N altar facing East  
Party to bow with Celebrant  
Turn clockwise or inward (if in pairs)  
Move off West

**X**  
**Torch 1 Torch 2**  
**Gospel Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon**  
**Gospeller (ordained)**

**Station**  
**2/3 nave going W**

**X face East**  
**Torches face N/S**  
**Book Bearer/ Liturgical Deacon between torches and face E**  
**Gospeller (ordained) W)**

At the conclusion of the Gospel

- \*Book to face N
- \*Gospeller to face S
- \*X comes through
- \*Torches follow
- \*Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon
- \*Gospeller

Then as entrance procession.

**Offertory**

- **When hymn is announced**  
Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon to remove sacred vessels from Credence onto Corporal removed from Burse on altar
  - \*Priest's chalice with paten and burse on top to Corporal at 6 o' clock
  - \*Charged chalices 3 and 9 o' clock
  - \*Burse standing 2 o' clock to corporal
  - \*Veil folded E of Burse

**During last verse of hymn**

- \*Taperers to receive Gift of the People
- \*Gifts handed to Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon
- \* Offertory party to part and stand N&S
- \*Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon to place Ciborium on Corporal at 12 o'clock
- \*Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon to charge priest's chalice from flagon and replace pall.
- \*Flagon to be placed 11 o'clock on Corporal
- \*Celebrant to altar
- \*Collection brought forward
- \*Collection received by Crucifer who faces East and elevates salver
- \*Celebrant blesses collection.
- \*Offertory party bows and departs.

**Eucharistic Prayer**

- Crucifer to bell rope  
Torch bearers to stations, kneeling E  
First elevation 3 rings, torches raised  
Second Elevation 3rings, torches raised  
Doxology 9 rings torches raised  
Crucifer and torch bearers to places during *The Lord's Prayer*.

### **Agnus Dei**

- Book Bearer/ Liturgical Deacon to remove reserved sacrament from aumbry to altar corporal

### **Invitation to Communion**

- Sides persons to insert altar-rail bar  
Eucharistic assistant to altar party  
Altar party to receive communion in semi-circle pointing W

### **After Distribution (with or without covering music)**

- Celebrant reverently to consume/reserve
- Sidespersons to remove altar bar
- Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon:
  - \*Flagon, ciborium and chalices removed to credence
  - \*Paten and Priest's chalice to be placed under pall, veil and burse (altar corporal inside) and removed to credence.
  - \*Reserved Sacrament to aumbry

### **Blessing and Dismissal**

#### **Recessional hymn**

- Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon to remove books and stand to Credence:  
On cue from Celebrant:  
\*Station Facing East

**X (W)**  
**Torch 1, Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon, Torch 2**  
**Celebrant (E)**

\*With Celebrant bow turn W clockwise or inward if in pair

**Choir**  
**Torch 1 Torch 2**  
**Book Bearer/Liturgical Deacon**  
**Celebrant**
