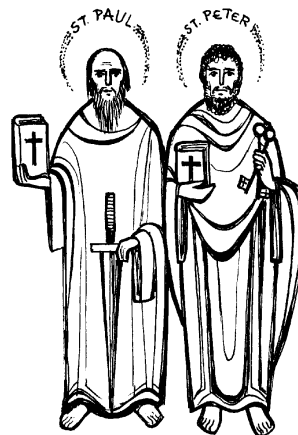

**NOTES ON THE READINGS**

**The First Reading**

Peter is arrested, but, with angelic aid, escapes the clutches of Herod, to live, and preach, another day.

**The Responsorial Psalm**

The psalmist gives thanks to God for his faithfulness and for the angelic intervention at a time of peril.

**The Second Reading**

Paul has confidence in God's promise and faithfulness - after all, he has experienced his help over many years of preaching and teaching.

**The Gospel**

With typical bravado, Peter jumps in with both feet and proclaims the Lord's Messiahship. Jesus, in return, confers on him "the power of the Keys," thus entrusted to Peter and his successors, the apostles and bishops, throughout the ages and for all eternity.
