'Tis a gift to be simple

The goings-on in the straits of Hormuz have kept us baffled and worried for months. One element, however, has hardly been mentioned - the crews of all those ships caught in the standstill. It is no fun being stuck in such a hot place eking out fuel and food. Some crews will have been looked after; others less so. I am sensitive to this because my last parish was Harwich with its ferry and cruise ship port and view across the river to Felixstowe marvelling at the biggest merchant ships in the world. I was involved in a very small way in ministering to the crews as an honorary chaplain of the Mission to Seafarers. Thank goodness we had a superb fulltime chaplain with a great team of people doing ship visits, driving crew members around, looking after them in hospital. Chaplains were always welcome onboard and could speak to everyone, whatever their background, from the captain to the newest recruit.

I used to enjoy the monthly meetings in the seafarer's centre getting to know about that hidden world of a big port but, above all, about the life of those who go down to the sea in ships. It is far from romantic. We may have massive ships, but they have tiny crews and with the watch system there is not much chance of the famed sailor camaraderie. It can be an amazingly lonely and boring life so the sight of someone coming to ask after you was always welcome. Our parish furnished a simple lounge where crew members could come and zoom their families on the other side of the world. It was well received.

The big surprise was that what symbolised the work were woolly hats. People all over the country would knit them never guessing what an impact they had. I remember taking several boxes full to the Felixstowe centre and in an hour or so they were all gone - gratefully received by seafarers braving the cold northern climes.

Such a simple gift; but so important. We all know that a simple act of kindness and love can transform our lives. In church we are very good at debating ideas, but faith is found in action. Faith is seen in the smile of a Filipino seafarer who can see and talk to his family. Jesus was very simple "what you do to the least of my children you do unto me". The MtoS (as well as other organisations) for me are a template for the church – practical and loving in God's name.

By now, they have probably finished unloading the items for our shops for this Christmas. When you do your shopping have a thought and a prayer for those who brought our goods around the world.

The theme of Sea Sunday (July 12th) this year is "Be a Harbour of Hope". What a good motto for Christians and all who care.

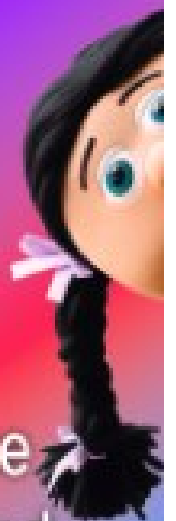

When doubts trouble our minds and prayers feel hard to speak, remind us that You hear us still in the quiet places of our souls.

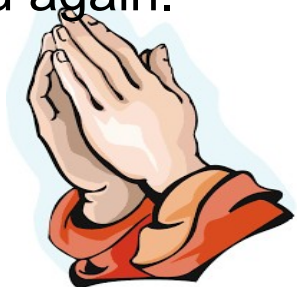
Lead us, as the psalmist says, to green pastures and quiet waters. Let Your calm steady our breathing and Your presence renew our strength.

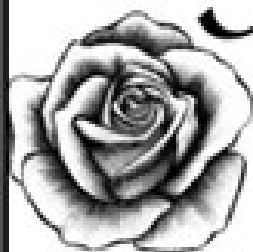

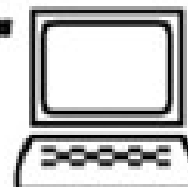
