**THE CHARITY OF THE MONTH FOR JUNE IS “HEARING DOGS FOR DEAF PEOPLE”** which trains dogs to alert deaf people to sounds they would otherwise miss – simple sounds that many people take for granted like the doorbell, alarm clock and even danger signals like the fire alarm. Being aware of these – thanks to a hearing dog – makes a real difference to deaf people’s lives. But the clever canines do so much more than alert their recipient to sounds. Deafness can be a very isolating disability. A hearing dog can give a deaf person a newfound sense of independence and confidence and be a loyal companion and a true friend by their side.

**THE CHARITY OF THE MONTH FOR JULY & AUGUST IS “SUTTON SCHOOLSWORK”**, a very local charity, which supports the provision of collective worship in Sutton's schools to increase the much needed knowledge and understanding of the Christian faith among our local children and young people which, in some cases, they will not otherwise ever receive. It employs two full-time schools’ workers, one working in Sutton's primary schools and the other in Sutton's secondary schools. Their work includes Bible based assemblies and Religious Education lessons.
