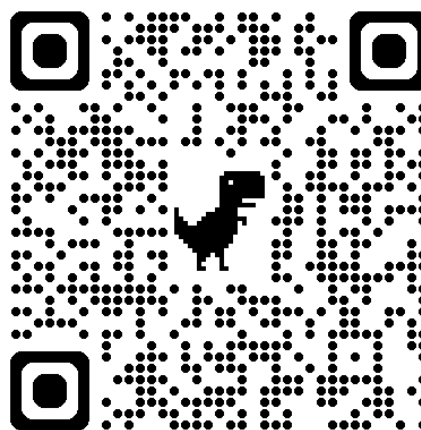
Everyone is welcome at our Church Movie Night – a feel-good story with a big ark and an even bigger message!

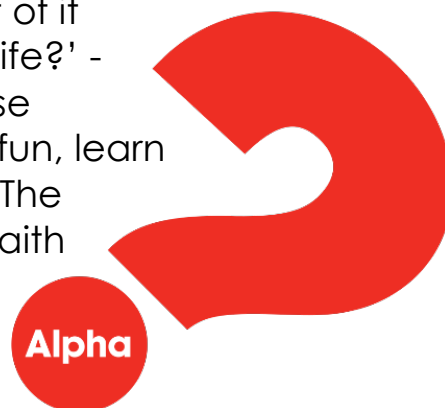
## Songs of Praise: Sunday 19th July 2026
