THE CHARITY OF THE MONTH FOR JULY & AUGUST IS “SUTTON SCHOOLSWORK”, a very local charity, which supports the provision of collective worship in Sutton's schools to increase the much needed knowledge and understanding of the Christian faith among our local children and young people which, in some cases, they will not otherwise ever receive. It employs two full-time schools' workers, one working in Sutton's primary schools and the other in Sutton's secondary schools. Their work includes Bible based assemblies and Religious Education lessons.
