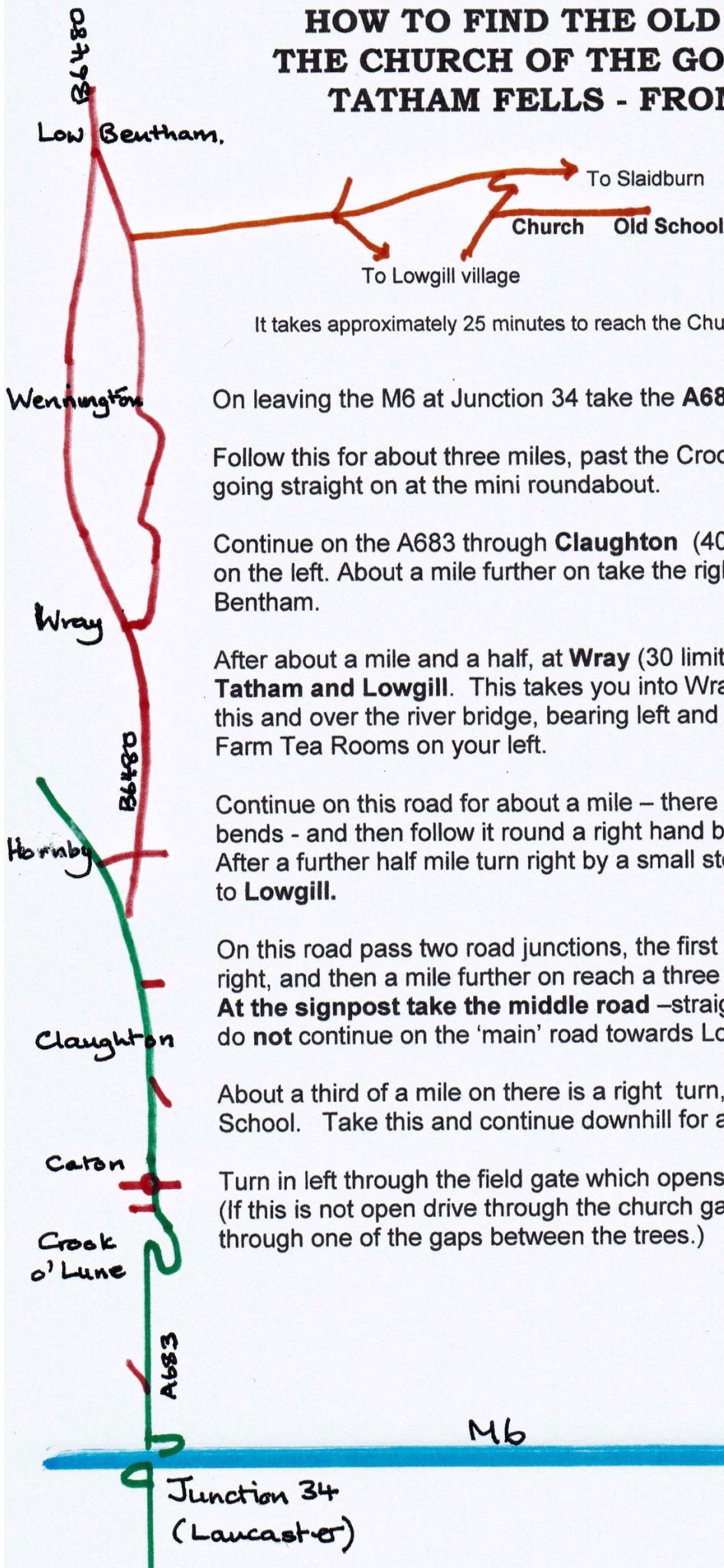


HOW TO FIND THE OLD SCHOOL AND THE CHURCH OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD, TATHAM FELLS - FROM THE WEST

It takes approximately 25 minutes to reach the Church and Old School from the M6

On leaving the M6 at Junction 34 take the **A683** towards Kirkby Lonsdale.

Follow this for about three miles, past the Crook-o-Lune to **Caton** (30 limit) going straight on at the mini roundabout.

Continue on the A683 through **Cloughton** (40 limit) passing the brickworks on the left. About a mile further on take the right turn signposted **B6480** Bentham.

After about a mile and a half, at **Wray** (30 limit), take the right turn to **Higher Tatham and Lowgill**. This takes you into Wray Main Street, drive through this and over the river bridge, bearing left and passing the Bridge House Farm Tea Rooms on your left.

Continue on this road for about a mile – there are two very sharp left hand bends - and then follow it round a right hand bend and up a steep hill. After a further half mile turn right by a small stone 'bus shelter' onto the road to **Lowgill**.

On this road pass two road junctions, the first on the left, the second on the right, and then a mile further on reach a three way junction.

At the signpost take the middle road –straight on towards Slaidburn, do **not** continue on the 'main' road towards Lowgill Village.

About a third of a mile on there is a right turn, signposted Church and Old School. Take this and continue downhill for about another third of a mile.

Turn in left through the field gate which opens onto the main parking area. (If this is not open drive through the church gates and turn into the car park through one of the gaps between the trees.)

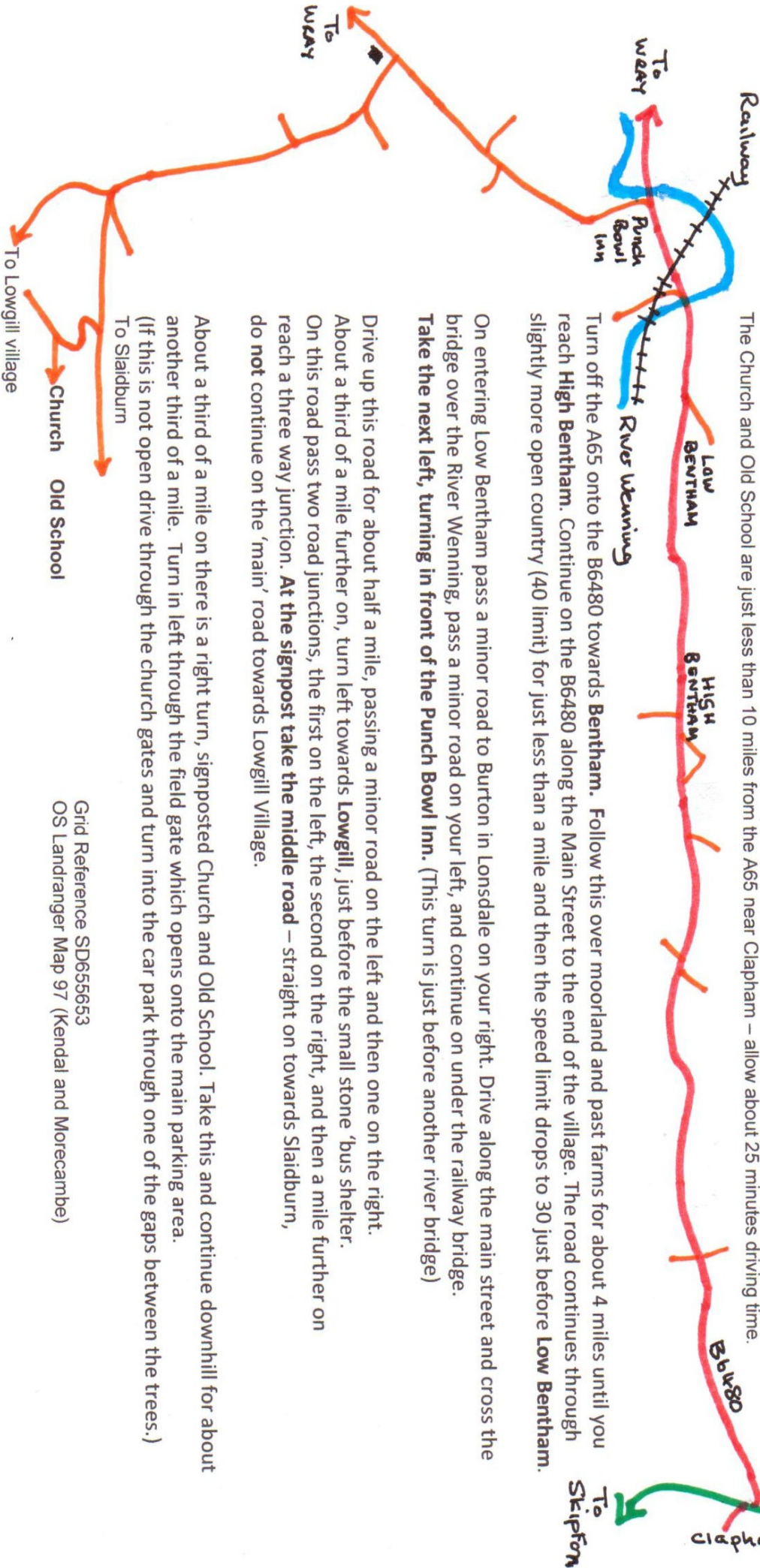
The Church and Old School are just less than 10 miles from the A65 near Clapham – allow about 25 minutes driving time.

Turn off the A65 onto the B6480 towards Bentham. Follow this over moorland and past farms for about 4 miles until you reach **High Bentham**. Continue on the Main Street to the end of the village. The road continues through slightly more open country (40 limit) for just less than a mile and then the speed limit drops to 30 just before **Low Bentham**.

On entering Low Bentham pass a minor road to Burton in Lonsdale on your right. Drive along the main street and cross the bridge over the River Wenning, pass a minor road on your left, and continue on under the railway bridge. **Take the next left, turning in front of the Punch Bowl Inn.** (This turn is just before another river bridge)

Drive up this road for about half a mile, passing a minor road on the left and then one on the right. About a third of a mile further on, turn left towards **Lowgill**, just before the small stone 'bus shelter'. On this road pass two road junctions, the first on the left, the second on the right, and then a mile further on reach a three way junction. **At the signpost take the middle road** – straight on towards Slaidburn, do **not** continue on the 'main' road towards Lowgill Village.

About a third of a mile on there is a right turn, signposted Church and Old School. Take this and continue downhill for about another third of a mile. Turn in left through the field gate which opens onto the main parking area.
