NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Demolish the existing church hall (former RAF hut) and reorder the church interior, comprising:

- (1) Introduction of a timber-clad serverly within the western bay of the north aisle;
- (2) Introduction of 2no WCs (1no accessible) into the current vestry (northeast), with storage mezzanine above, and with associated ramp from aisle and minor modification to existing timber screen;
- (3) Removal of all existing nave pews, and introduction of 80no wooden Theo chairs (some with arms) and associated portable stacking units;
- (4) Replacement of floor in nave with new flagstones and removal of font plinth;
- (5) Removal of existing timber internal lobby and introduction of new glazed lobby to the south door entrance;
- (6) Introduction of 4no Herschel heating/lighting Halos through nave and chancel, 2no Horizon infrared units in north aisle, and 4no Krystal/Aspect heating units in new WCs area, with all associated electrics upgrade and zoned controls;
- (7) Introduction of supplementary LED lights in the north aisle, WC, kitchen, and to spotlight altar, lectern, pulpit and font.

Directions to petitioner

You must display this public notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 28 days, not counting the day on which it was put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct and subject to any special directions of the registrar) in each of the following places:

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
