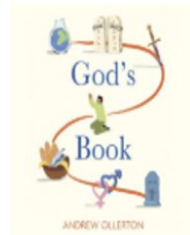

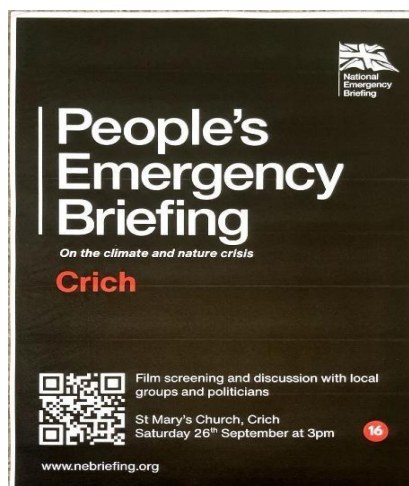
Members of Transition Crich and St Mary's Church have joined forces to bring The People's Emergency Briefing to Crich.
